A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR...

Our Administrative Council met and discussed what it will take to safely reopen our church building for worship. With that in mind we must remember that Maryland is into Phase 2 on the road to recovery. The Ad Council will meet on July 6th to discuss possible dates for returning. Needless to say, things will be different than they were before the pandemic.

- Two services will be offered on Sunday morning in the fellowship hall. This will allow for easier social distancing. Please only choose to attend one service so we can spread out our worshipers more safely.
- All other areas of the building will be closed. Two sets of doors will be opened (patio entrance and kitchen entrance).
- All in attendance must wear masks for the time being and we have extra masks on hand should a member/guest not bring their own.
- ➤ People will be asked to tell us in advance which service they will attend each week. Contact information will be verified.
- ➤ Hand sanitizer will be available for us before entering the building. Temperatures will also be taken with a touch-less thermometer.
- Ushers will seat individuals and families.
- > Services will be shortened to forty-five minutes to allow for cleaning in between services.
- There will be no nursery or Sunday school for the time being.
- If possible, please use your home bathroom before coming to church. Everything must be sanitized after each use. Our restrooms will be available for emergencies.
- We will maintain six feet of separation from those not in one household as best we can. Unfortunately, this means no hugging or shaking hands for now.
- We will refrain from congregational singing for the time being due to the potential of spreading the disease.
- > At the end of the service people will be dismissed by row or table to prevent overcrowding.
- > Offerings and tithes can safely be dropped off in offering plates as you leave.
- All will be asked to maintain social distancing in the parking lot.

While I know these worship services will be far different than we are used to, we will at least be together and worshiping God. Hopefully this situation will not last long. We must continue to pray for an end to the pandemic.

I also want you to know that even though we will be offering worship at our church again, if you do not feel comfortable attending right now please stay home. Also, if you are not feeling 100% please stay home.

We are doing our best to make the situation as safe as possible, but we can't control all variables. If you cannot attend worship at the church, we will continue to offer online services and children's church.

This will be an evolving process as we figure out what works best and we will make adjustments as necessary. Also, if for some reason we should revert back to phase one with the county or state, we will have to go back to strictly worshipping online.




How it Works
